DR. GAVIN EWING

Dr. Gavin Ewing discovered his passion for dentistry while shadowing his family dentist during his junior year of college. Inspired by the ability to positively impact patients' lives, he earned a BS in Chemistry from The College of New Jersey and completed his dental degree at Columbia College of Dental Medicine, where he was active in student government and researched dental anxiety.

He graduated in the top nine of his class and was inducted into the Omicron Kappa Upsilon National Dental Honor Society. Dr. Ewing then completed a General Practice Residency at the Sepulveda VA near Los Angeles, gaining advanced training in endodontics, oral surgery, implants, and full-mouth rehabilitation.

Afterward, he moved to Alameda, managed a group practice office in Pleasanton, and became a clinical director. In 2019, Dr. Ewing acquired a traditional dental office and transformed it into a state of the art, comprehensive practice where his clinical scope ranges from general dentistry to complex restorative and full mouth reconstruction. Notably, Dr. Ewing is recognized as an expert in FP1 full arch rehabilitation, specializing in achieving highly aesthetic, natural looking results for edentulous patients.
